

July 29-August 2, 2019

HIGHLIGHTS

- Visit the southwestern tip of the continent to view a colony of African penguins.
- Hike on the trails of Table Mountain National Park and at the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve.
- Take a boat trip to Seal Island, home to an estimated 64,000 Cape fur seals.
- Stroll through the world-renowned Kirstenbosch National Botanical Garden.
- Enjoy waterfront dining on Cape Town's famous wharf.

Extend your Southern Africa journey amid the stunning natural landscapes and wildlife of South Africa's Cape Peninsula. From your base in cosmopolitan Cape Town, you'll have the opportunity to explore jagged coastline, and walk through native vegetation and cultivated gardens. We'll learn about the rich, complicated history of South Africa.

ITINERARY

BLD = BREAKFAST, LUNCH, DINNER

JULY 29 - VICTORIA FALLS

The Trip Extension begins with some free time in the afternoon to rest and catch your breath after some full days. Enjoy the lodge's property and pool or explore on your own. Dinner tonight at the Boma Restaurant is four courses of Zimbabwean cuisine with an impressive African drumming performance. *Overnight at A'Zambezi Lodge. (D)*

JULY 30 - CAPE TOWN

Today we transfer from Victoria Falls to Cape Town, South Africa. Over dinner, Sharon will provide an orientation to Cape Town and a preview of our upcoming hikes and activities. The modern and luxurious Radisson Blu Hotel is situated directly on the azure waterfront of the Atlantic Ocean. *Overnight at Radisson Blu Waterfront. (BD)*

JULY 31 - CAPE TOWN

We'll start our exploration of Cape Town with a cableway trip to the top of Table Mountain (weather permitting) and a hike on the trails of Table Mountain National Park. After lunch together, we'll stroll through the world-renowned Kirstenbosch National Botanical Garden. Dinner this evening is on your own, or with Sharon. Choose from a plethora of fine restaurants along the famous wharf. *Overnight at Radisson Blu Waterfront. (BL)*

AUGUST 1 - CAPE TOWN

Today we hike at the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve. We'll visit the southwestern tip of the African continent to view a penguin colony and enjoy the Seal Island Boat Tour. At dinner tonight we celebrate the end of our adventure together in Africa. *Overnight at Radisson Blu Waterfront. (BLD)*

AUGUST 2 - DEPARTURE

Have breakfast and transfer to the Cape Town airport. Extra nights in Cape Town or Johannesburg on your own can be arranged through Holbrook Travel. *(B)*
